Dear Family and Friends of El Shaddai,

El Shaddai Christian School is getting ready to open very soon for the 2009-2010 school year. We have 105 students enrolled at this time and 75 of them are Kindergartners. There will be one first year Kindergarten class, one second year Kindergarten class, and two third year Kindergarten classes. We will also have First Grade, Third Grade, and Fifth Grade this year. We praise the Lord for this increase and know that the Lord will help supply for these additional needs.

We are praying for another teacher to join us at El Shaddai. We are so thankful for our staff and their dedication to the Lord and to the children. We know that God has the perfect person to join this ministry and we would like to ask you to pray with us concerning this need.

We also had a need for more chairs for our school and glory to God the need has been met. The chairs have been ordered, so please join us in prayer that we receive them before the opening of school.

Our prayer is that uniforms and shoes are provided for each child in El Shaddai Christian School and also for all the children in the Dessources area that attend other schools. The cost of uniforms for all the students in El Shaddai Christian School is approximately \$1,600. This will give each returning student one uniform and each new student two uniforms. Again please join us in prayer that the Lord will meet this need. We praise God that many of the shoes have been provided for the children but we are believing God to provide every child a pair of shoes for school. God knows the need and He is always faithful.

We would like to continue to provide a snack/lunch for the children each day and trust God to supply all we need for this. We feel this is important to enhance the learning ability of each child. Our menu is as follows:

Mon. - Cereal with Milk
Tues. - Oatmeal
Wed. - Peanut Butter Sandwich & Juice
Thurs. - Cereal with Milk
Fri. - Peanut Butter Sandwich & Juice

At this time, we have cereal and milk sent to us, but peanut butter and oatmeal are two items we will continually need throughout the year. As the Lord provides, we would also love to give the children boiled eggs, crackers & cheese, and even different types of fruit such as cantaloupe, banana, watermelon, etc...

Another area that has expanded due to the increase in enrollment is the payroll. Please pray with us as we seek the Lord for provision in this area. Our monthly budget for payroll is approximately \$3,000.

We thank you for your continued support and prayers as we embark on another exciting year at El Shaddai Christian School in Dessources where God is raising up a new generation for the Lord! May the Lord continue to bless you!
